HOW HOME HEALTH SERVICES WORK

Healthy Living at Home has services provided by on-call nurses 7 days a week, 24 hours a day. Once we receive an order from your doctor we will contact you to ask when you would like us to come to your home.

We are committed to visit our patients shortly after you are discharged from the hospital, skilled nursing facility, or after we receive notification from your doctor. However, you can determine when you would like us to provide the initial visit.

On our initial visit a Nurse or a Physical Therapist will provide an evaluation to determine your current medical and functional status. Based on your needs, other clinicians such as Occupational Therapists or Medical Social Workers may also provide additional evaluations. From the evaluations and your input, we will develop a plan of care that will assist you to move toward independence.
