All Assisted Living Services are planned with the understanding that resident's individual needs change over time. In planning and providing services we always consider the unique interests, attributes, abilities and overall health status of each resident. Residents are always encouraged to perform as many of their activities of daily living as they are able.

Resident service plans are created and reviewed on a regular basis with the involvement of each resident, family members, and key staff members to ensure the appropriateness of the direction, scope, and degree of the services being provided.

Assisted Living services are supervised by a licensed nurse and include medication monitoring, grooming, and bathing assistance, personal laundry and many other services.

Charges for individual personal care service plans are determined through an assessment process using a point based scoring method. Located on the second floor of Laurel Parc is Laurel Parc's very own licensed assisted living community.

Points are determined by frequency and duration of your individual service needs, as well as direct and indirect cost of performing the service. The assessment will reflect a point total and a total charge for services provided.

You may add, cancel, or modify services as your needs change. Best of all, you pay for only the services needed. This approach most accurately ensures that the charge for the care services fees directly reflects your personal and individual service needs.

Public Transportation Options

TRI MET LIFT Para-transit Program

LIFT is a shared-ride public transit transportation service. LIFT service operates during the same hours as bus and MAX services, generally 4:30 am - 2:30 am, seven days a week. Rides are by advance reservation and must be requested no later than 5:00 pm the day before the trip. The cost to use their service is \$1.80 per trip.

You can call **503-962-8000** to request an application or you can visit their website (http://trimet.org/lift/index.htm). It can take up to three weeks for them to process your application so apply well in advance if you plan on using their services.

Ride Connection

Ride Connection is a non-profit organization that provides transportation options for older adults.
