What is hospice?

Samaritan Evergreen Hospice has two locations serving patients and families in Benton, Lincoln, Linn, Marion, Polk and portions of Tillamook counties.

Hospice is a philosophy of care for people who are in the last stages of a terminal illness such as cancer, emphysema or organ failure. Hospice preserves the patient's right to live out the remainder of their life with dignity and compassionate symptom management, in the surroundings they choose. Hospice does not hasten death. It affirms life and regards dying as a normal part of life's journey.

Whenever possible, hospice patients stay in the familiar surroundings of their own homes, in an atmosphere of dignity and support for the patient and the family.

If a patient is living at a nursing home, assisted living facility or foster home, hospice care can be provided at that location, too. We also offer a hospice house, located in Albany, to provide respite care as well as short stays for patients needing advanced symptom management.

All medical care provided by our hospice staff is conducted under the direction of the patient's own health care provider, who may continue to direct all care.

What services does hospice offer?

Our dedicated team of professionals help the patient and family by offering:

- Skilled nursing care (24-hour, on-call nursing services available)
- Comfort care (pain and symptom management)
- Medical social services and counseling
- Spiritual support
- Hospice aides
- Trained hospice volunteers
- Bereavement support
- Medication and equipment as appropriate

Who should use hospice?

Hospice assists people of all ages who are under the care of a physician. Hospice is for people who:

- Have a terminal diagnosis with a life expectancy of six months or less
- Have approval of their attending physician who may continue to direct all care
- Are seeking comfort care rather than a cure

We recognize these special needs of the dying:

- Symptom management
- To be close to loved ones
- Quality of life for the patient and family
- Bereavement support for family

Our staff and volunteers support patients and family members through the final stages of illness. Ongoing contact and support for the family is offered through our bereavement program.
