# In-Home Care: Understanding Your Options

## *Home Care is the preferred choice*

Non-medical home care is a service that assists those in need to continue living and celebrating life from the comfort of their own homes. Home care is a model of care that is comprised of both professional and informal support networks, including family, neighbors, and friends. These individuals construct your 'Care Team' which helps you to meet your goals and expected outcomes. At some point, you may determine that a professional in-home care company is needed to join your Care Team.

## *Considering your options*

When selecting a home care services company, you will have many questions. The first thing to understand is that home care services vary from facility-based options. Chances are if you're researching senior care you've heard a lot about senior options such as a nursing home, assisted living community, adult day care, retirement community, or continuing care retirement community (or CCRC). ### • **Home Care Agency:**

This model of home care can help to fill in the gaps that skilled care services do not cover. Agencies typically employ caregivers, manage payroll and taxes, and professionally supervise and monitor their caregivers to ensure client satisfaction.

### • **Private Hire or Independent Providers:**

Usually this service involves the family sourcing, screening, and hiring a caregiver directly. This process can be risky as the recruiting time is very resource intensive and opens more possibilities that you could hire an unqualified aide.
