# What Sensi AI Can Detect

Sensi listens for patterns and changes in daily life, alerting us to things that may need attention:

## Safety & Emergencies

- Falls or possible fall risk
- Difficulty reaching help or using equipment
- Safety concerns (including possible self-harm)
- Emergency events requiring EMS

## Health Changes

- Pain or discomfort
- Possible infection (UTI, respiratory, pneumonia, etc.)
- Medication issues (missed doses, side effects, changes)
- Changes in vital signs, sleep, or appetite
- Symptoms such as dizziness, fatigue, or swelling

## Cognitive & Emotional Wellbeing

- Memory concerns, confusion, or disorientation
- Mood changes (low mood, resistance to care, anxiety)
- Signs of loneliness or lack of companionship
- Speech or neurological changes

## Daily Living & Independence

- Difficulty with activities of daily living (showing, eating, toileting, mobility, transfers)
- Care resistance (hesitation with help, refusing medication, etc.)
- Reduced activity levels or changes in routine

- Chronic condition changes
- Hospitalizations or test results
- Positive interactions or improvements in wellbeing
- Alerts to possible need for additional care or caregiver support
