What You Must Know:

- ◆ Hospice is 100% covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and most commercial insurances.
- ◆ Patients diagnosed as terminally ill with a life expectancy of six months or less are eligible for hospice care benefits.
- ◆ The patient must choose to elect the hospice benefit.
- ◆ Hospice is not a place – services are provided wherever the patient calls home.
- ◆ The patient decides who oversees the care plan and can continue with the family physician.
- ◆ Hospice doesn't mean giving up hope.
- ◆ Hospice care supports the entire family.
